Course Guidelines for Calculus and College Prep Math

- I. Materials needed daily
 - A. Textbook
 - B. Notebook- All textbook assignments and notes from class discussions will be kept in your notebook. The notebook will either be collected at the end of a chapter or graded on a daily basis. Label all notes and assignments by date, section number, and page number.
 - C. Pencil- Everything in this class must be completed with a pencil.
 - D. Completed assignments
- II. Home excused absences ie.. illness
 - A. The initiative to find out what assignments or tests were missed is left to the students.
 - B. It is the student's responsibility to find out what he/she missed and complete the assignments or test at a proper time.
 - C. Previously assigned homework will be due the day the student returns to class.
 - D. For each day the student is absent, he/she will receive two days to make up the test, quiz, or assignment. (See Student Handbook for details.)
- III. School excused absences ie.. field trips
 - A. Homework assignments are due on the date they were assigned due.
 - B. Tests will be taken on or before the date which it was assigned.
- IV. Unexcused absences ie.. skipping class
 - A. Students will receive a zero for the day.
 - B. Students will be disciplined according to the Student Handbook.
- V. Tardiness ie.. late for class
 - A. A student will be marked tardy if he/she is not completely in the classroom when the bell stops ringing. Students in the room but not in their assigned seats, must proceed to their desks.
 - B. If detained by another teacher, the student must get a pass from the teacher before coming to class.
 - C. Students will be disciplined according to the Student Handbook.
- VI. Misbehavior ie.. acting inappropriate
 - A. Appropriate school behavior is expected at all times.

- B. Misconduct will first be handled by the teacher.
- C. If behavior becomes intolerable, the student will be sent to the Dean's Office.
- D. All rules from the Student Handbook apply to everyone.

VII. Miscellaneous rules

- A. Food or drinks are not permitted in the room or in the halls. (You may have water only)
- B. Defacing school property will result in a thorough cleaning and a trip to the Dean's Office.
- C. Cheating will not be tolerated and will result in an automatic zero.
- D. No more than 50% credit will be given to work that is handed in late.
- E. No credit will be given to work that is handed in over one week late.
- F. Do not touch the windows or blinds.


